Prerequisites

The training assumes that the participants have a basic understanding of TCP/IP and network protocols. Without this knowledge it may not be possible to take full advantage of the training.

Participants are required to bring a laptop running Windows 2000, Windows Xp or Windows Vista. The laptop will be used for the exercises and full administrative privileges are required to install software used in the exercises.

If the AppGate IP Tunneling driver or the AppGate Device Firewall are previously installed on the laptop they must be disabled to start with.

The laptop must have an Ethernet interface and a USB port.
